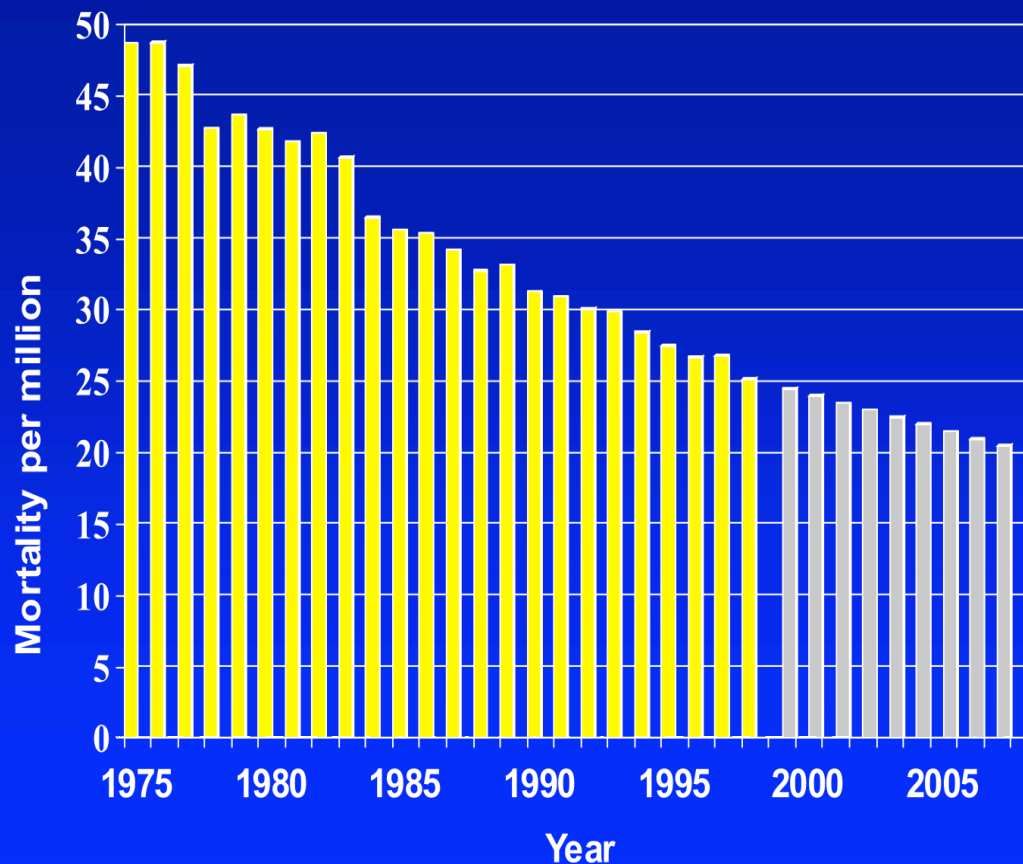


Putting the Kids Back in Health Care Reform

Childhood Cancer Mortality

■ Actual: 1975-98 (~50% decrease in past 23 years)
(~25% decrease in past decade)

■ Projected: 1999-2008 (~20% projected further decrement)

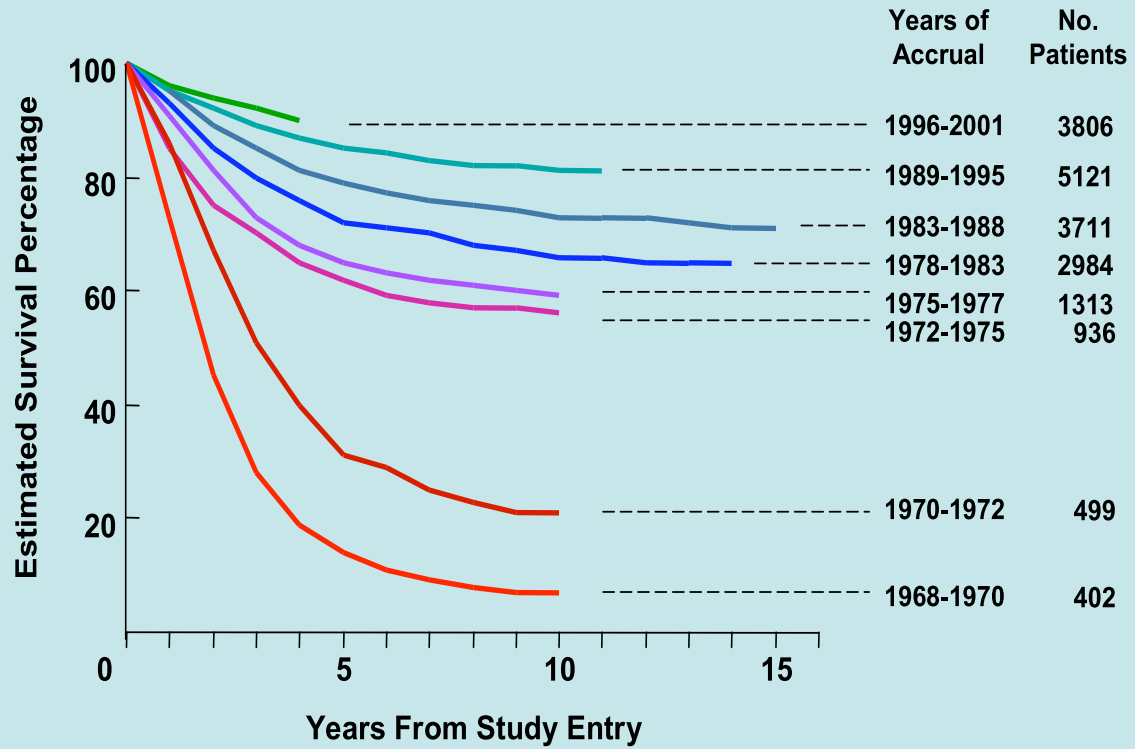
